WHEREAS, cultural workers and artists contribute not only to cultural preservation but also to education, social cohesion, community engagement, and the creative economy of the City;

WHEREAS, barangays, schools, cultural institutions, faith-based organizations, and community groups play an important role in identifying and supporting cultural workers and tradition bearers within their communities;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the importance of fostering an enabling environment where cultural workers, artists, and tradition bearers are valued, supported, and are encouraged to share knowledge and skills.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to recognize and encourage, as it does hereby recognize and encourage, support for cultural workers, artists, and traditional bearers in Quezon City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that barangays be encouraged to identify, acknowledge, and engage cultural workers, artists, and tradition bearers in community-based cultural, educational, and heritage activities.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that concerned City offices, including the Quezon City Tourism Department and the Quezon City Public Library, be encouraged to collaborate on initiatives that provide platforms, documentation, and opportunities for cultural workers to showcase and share their work, subject to existing policies and resources.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that schools and educational institutions be encouraged to involve cultural workers and tradition bearers in appropriate learning activities, workshops, and cultural programs to promote intergenerational learning.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that youth organizations, including the Sangguniang Kabataan, be encouraged to support and participate in programs that engage cultural workers and promote appreciation of local arts, traditions, and cultural practices.
