A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT – NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION (DSWD-NCR) FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SUPPLEMENTARY FEEDING PROGRAM (SFP) IN QUEZON CITY FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 11037, otherwise known as the Masustansyang Pagkain Para sa Batang Pilipino Act, the State adopts a comprehensive National Feeding Program to address undernutrition among Filipino children;

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) is the primary government agency mandated to develop, implement, and coordinate social protection programs, including the Supplementary Feeding Program (SFP) for children aged three (3) to five (5) years old enrolled in Child Development Centers (CDCs);

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WHEREAS, the SFP provides nutritious meals in addition to the regular diet of children to improve their nutritional status, in coordination with Local Government Units (LGUs);

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the Social Services Development Department, CDCs, the Quezon City Health Department, and other relevant offices, plays a vital role in the implementation, monitoring, and delivery of nutrition and child welfare services pursuant to the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the DSWD, through its Field Office – National Capital Region, proposes to implement the SFP in Quezon City, covering eligible child beneficiaries for a feeding period of one hundred eighty (180) days;

WHEREAS, the DSWD shall shoulder the funding requirements for the implementation of the SFP, including the procurement and delivery of food commodities and other necessary program support for the said 180-day feeding period, in accordance with existing laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the program requires the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the DSWD-NCR and the Quezon City Government to define the roles, responsibilities, and commitments of both parties;

WHEREAS, the said MOA aims to ensure the effective and efficient delivery of feeding services, proper monitoring, reporting, and compliance with national guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Social Welfare and Development – National Capital Region (DSWD-NCR) for the implementation of the Supplementary Feeding Program (SFP) in Quezon City for Calendar Year 2026.

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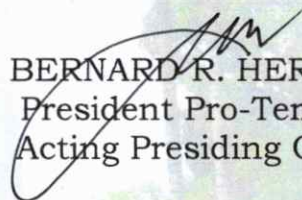
RESOLVED FURTHER, that the said MOA shall form an integral part of this Resolution.
