RESOLUTION NO. SP- **10478**, S-2026

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE RENEWAL OF MARKET FRANCHISE TO SABINA MARKET FOR THE OPERATION OF THE WET AND DRY MARKET KNOWN AS THE "SABINA MARKET INC.," LOCATED AT NO. 18 QUIRINO HIGHWAY CORNER J.P. RAMOY STREET, BARANGAY TALIPAPA, DISTRICT VI, QUEZON CITY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH AND SUBJECT TO THE PERTINENT PROVISIONS OF THE QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-2459, S-2015, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "REVISED MARKET CODE"

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2459, S-2015, otherwise known as the Revised Market Code, was enacted by the Quezon City Council in order to integrate all laws and ordinances for a more efficient and organized system of regulation of public markets and market-related activities to safeguard the interest of the consumers;

WHEREAS, it is the legislative intent of the Quezon City Council to require new and existing private markets to secure market franchise from the Quezon City Council subject to renewal every after five (5) years;

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WHEREAS, Section 1.4, Article III of the Revised Market Code provides that no person, partnership, or corporation shall operate a private market within Quezon City without first securing a franchise from the Quezon City Council. The same Section further provides that all franchise to operate granted to private markets shall be reapplied for renewal every five (5) years;

WHEREAS, the Sabina Market is a private wet and dry market, located at No. 18 Quirino Highway corner J.P. Ramoy Street, Barangay Talipapa, District VI, Quezon City, operated by Sabina Market Inc.;

WHEREAS, the Sabina Market Inc. has complied with all the documents necessary for the operation of the private wet and dry market, known as the Sabina Market, that will entitle it to be granted with a market franchise by the Quezon City Council pursuant to the Revised Market Code;

WHEREAS, a market franchise, being a mere privilege, may be withdrawn at any time by the Quezon City Government and is subject to the regulation, control, and limitation of the provisions of the Revised Market Code, Quezon City Revenue Code, and other applicable laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the non-fulfillment of the conditions of a granted market franchise and the continuing violation of the Revised Market Code, Quezon City Revenue Code, and other applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be grounds for the revocation or withdrawal of the market franchise, after observance of due process.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, the renewal of market franchise to Sabina Market Inc. for the operation of the wet and dry market known as the "Sabina Market," located at No. 18 Quirino Highway corner J.P. Ramoy Street, Barangay Talipapa, District VI, Quezon City, in accordance with and subject to the pertinent provisions of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2459, S-2015, otherwise known as the Revised Market Code.

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RESOLVED FURTHER, that the market franchise granted under this Resolution shall be effective for a period of five (5) years commencing from the date of its adoption, and subject to the payment of a franchise fee, and an annual franchise tax provided under Section 1.4.3, Article III of the Revised Market Code.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that in case Sabina Market Inc. sells and/or transfers the ownership or operation of the Sabina Market to any person or entity, the new owner or operator shall secure a new market franchise from the Quezon City Council.
