*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government continues to promote public health and consumer safety through initiatives that encourage responsible food preparation and handling;*

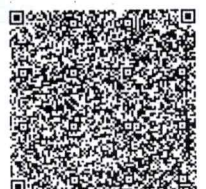
*WHEREAS, the rise of online platforms and home-based food businesses has made food products more accessible to the public;*

*WHEREAS, many residents have started small food enterprises from their homes or through online selling, providing livelihood opportunities and supporting the local economy;*

*WHEREAS, proper food safety practices such as hygienic food preparation, safe storage, and proper handling are essential in preventing foodborne illnesses;*

*WHEREAS, public awareness on food safety standards can help protect consumers and support responsible food entrepreneurship in the community;*

*WHEREAS, barangays, community organizations, and local government units can help promote safe food practices through information campaigns and community education.*



NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby encourage, food safety awareness among online and home-based food businesses in Quezon City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that barangays are encouraged to support information campaigns that promote safe food preparation, proper hygiene, and responsible food handling practices.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that online and home-based food sellers are encouraged to follow proper sanitation practices and ensure that food products are prepared, stored, and delivered in safe conditions.


RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that community seminars and information materials may be conducted to educate residents and small food entrepreneurs on basic food safety principles.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the Quezon City Health Department, the Business Permits and Licensing Department, all barangays in Quezon City, and other concerned offices for their information and appropriate action.
