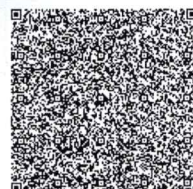

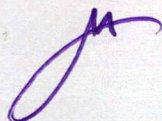

NOW, THEREFORE,

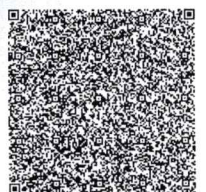

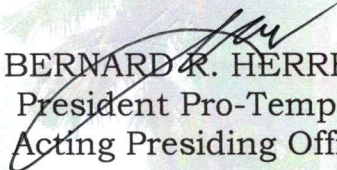
