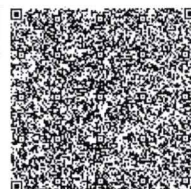

WHEREAS, Quezon City has long championed environmental sustainability and urban greening initiatives that promote a healthier and more livable City;

WHEREAS, the City is home to numerous parks, green spaces, and ecological areas such as the Quezon Memorial Circle, the La Mesa Eco Park, and other urban green corridors that serve as valuable recreational and ecological resources;

WHEREAS, many cities around the world promote eco-tourism and nature trails within urban environments to encourage residents and visitors to experience green spaces while learning about environmental protection and sustainability;



WHEREAS, establishing Green Tourism and Nature Trails in Quezon City can encourage citizens and visitors to explore parks, gardens, and ecological areas while promoting wellness, outdoor recreation, and environmental awareness;

WHEREAS, such initiatives may also support tourism while reinforcing the City's commitment to sustainability, climate action, and environmental education;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Tourism Department, together with relevant City departments and environmental organizations, is well positioned to promote eco-tourism activities that highlight the City's green spaces;

WHEREAS, this Resolution is in support of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3439, S-2025, otherwise known as the Quezon City Green Building Code of 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby encourage, the development and promotion of Quezon City Green Tourism and Nature Trails to highlight parks, urban green spaces, and ecological areas while promoting sustainable tourism and environmental awareness.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Quezon City Tourism Department is encouraged to prepare tourism guides, maps, and digital materials featuring recommended nature trails and green tourism destinations such as parks, gardens, and ecological areas.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that relevant City departments may support the initiative by enhancing visitor access, environmental signage, and educational materials that promote environmental awareness and responsible tourism practices.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that barangays located near parks and green spaces are encouraged to assist in maintaining cleanliness, safety, and environmental stewardship within areas included in the Nature Trails.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the sangguniang kabataan (SK) and youth organizations are encouraged to participate in environmental awareness campaigns, tree-planting activities, and eco-tourism promotion programs.









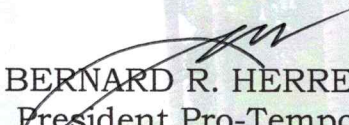
RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that non-governmental organizations, environmental groups, academic institutions, and community organizations may collaborate with the City Government in organizing eco-tours, environmental education programs, and conservation activities.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that private sector partners and businesses located near parks and Green Tourism areas are encouraged to support eco-tourism initiatives and promote responsible environmental practices that align with the City's sustainability goals.
