WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates local government units to prepare comprehensive development plans and corresponding investment programs through their respective Local Development Councils and integrate these into the local budgeting process;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through its City Development Council (CDC), has undertaken the revision of the City's Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP), which was adopted through Quezon City Resolution No. SP-10311, S-2025, covering the period 2026-2031, in response to significant demographic, economic, social, and environmental changes;

WHEREAS, pursuant to its mandate under the Local Government Code of 1991 and related planning and budgeting guidelines, the CDC is likewise tasked to prepare the City's Local Development Investment Program (LDIP);

WHEREAS, the LDIP serves as the medium-term investment framework that operationalizes the goals and strategies of the CDP and guides the preparation of the Annual Investment Program (AIP) and the annual budget of the City;

WHEREAS, the CDC conducted a participatory and multi-sectoral planning process, including consultations, technical working group sessions, and prioritization workshops, resulting in the identification and prioritization of one hundred thirty-eight (138) Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) for inclusion in the LDIP 2027-2029;

WHEREAS, during the CDC Regular Session held on April 17, 2026, presided over by CDC Chairperson, Honorable Mayor Josefina G. Belmonte, the prioritized PPAs and CDC Resolution No. 01, Series of 2026, entitled "A Resolution Adopting the Priority List of Programs and Projects for Inclusion in the Local Development Investment Program (LDIP) 2027-2029," were duly approved and adopted by the body;

WHEREAS, the finalized list of PPAs which collectively comprise the LDIP for 2027-2029 is hereby endorsed to the Quezon City Council for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to approve and adopt, as it does hereby approve and adopt, the Local Development Investment Program (LDIP) 2027-2029.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that all concerned departments and offices are hereby directed to align their respective programs, activities, and budget proposals with the priorities identified in the adopted LDIP 2027-2029.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that all implementing departments, offices and units shall coordinate with the City Planning and Development Department and the CDC Secretariat to ensure the effective and synchronized implementation of the LDIP 2027-2029.

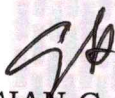
