WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes that a comprehensive, responsive, and well-coordinated Peace and Order and Public Safety (POPS) Plan is essential in fostering a safe, secure, resilient, and development-oriented environment for all QCitizens;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 773, series of 2009 provides for the reorganization of the Peace and Order Councils at all levels of local government and mandates Local Peace and Order Councils to recommend measures that will effectively maintain peace and order and enhance public safety within their respective jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 2019-143 enjoins all Local Peace and Order Councils to formulate and adopt a three (3)-year POPS Plan as a strategic planning instrument for addressing peace and order concerns and public safety issues within their areas of responsibility;



WHEREAS, the DILG has issued a Memorandum dated December 18, 2025 outlining the requirements for the formulation and finalization of the POPS Plan for the term 2026-2028, which must be completed within 200 days from the assumption of office of newly-elected Local Chief Executives. The POPS Plan should be integrated into local development plans to ensure funding and compliance with budget processes;

WHEREAS, the POPS Plan serves as a comprehensive and evidenced-based three (3)-year development plan that identifies priority concerns, strategic interventions, programs, projects and activities aimed at maintaining and enhancing peace and order, ensuring public safety, promoting community resilience, and safeguarding the welfare of the City's residents;

WHEREAS, the formulation of the 2026-2028 Quezon City POPS Plan was undertaken through a series of consultations, workshops, planning sessions, situational analyses, and collaborative activities involving concerned local government offices, law enforcement agencies, national government agencies, civil society organizations, and other stakeholders;

WHEREAS, the 2026-2028 QC POPS Plan adopts a holistic, integrated, and multi-sectoral approach in addressing prevailing and emerging peace and order concerns through programs and interventions on anti-criminality, anti-illegal drugs, anti-insurgency and prevention of violent extremism, public safety, disaster and crisis management, traffic and road safety, access to justice, community engagement, and institutional capacity-building;

WHEREAS, the said Plan is aligned with relevant national laws, policies and development frameworks, including the Philippine Development Plan, the National Peace and Order Framework, and other directives of the DILG, thereby ensuring coherence between local and national peace and security objectives;

WHEREAS, on 28 November 2025, the Quezon City Peace and Order Council formally adopted the QC POPS Plan for the years 2026-2028 and designated its Technical Working Group to oversee, monitor, and evaluate the implementation of the programs, projects, and activities identified therein;

WHEREAS, the adoption of the 2026-2028 QC POPS Plan by the Quezon City Council is necessary to institutionalize the same as an official policy framework of the City Government and to facilitate the integration of its identified programs, projects, and activities into the City's planning, budgeting, implementation, and monitoring processes.

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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to adopt, as it does hereby adopt, the Quezon City Peace and Order and Public Safety Plan for the years 2026-2028.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the programs and projects stated in the QC POPS Plan for the years 2026-2028 may be revised or amended, if the need arises.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that a copy of the QC POPS Plan for the years 2026-2028 shall form an integral part of this Resolution.

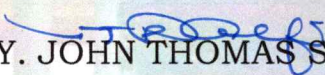
