WHEREAS, improper waste disposal, accumulation of combustible materials, and open burning of trash significantly increase the risk of fire in residential and commercial areas;

WHEREAS, discarded flammable materials such as aerosols, paint cans, chemicals, and improperly stored fuels pose serious hazards when exposed to heat;

WHEREAS, proper waste segregation, timely collection, and safe disposal practices contribute not only to environmental protection but also to fire risk reduction;

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WHEREAS, discouraging open burning and promoting responsible waste management strengthen both public safety and the environmental sustainability initiatives of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to promote, as it does hereby promote, proper waste management, discourage open burning, and encourage safe storage and disposal of flammable materials in Quezon City in line with Fire Prevention Month.

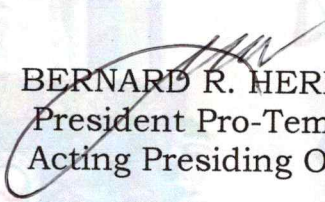

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to all concerned offices and barangays for their information and guidance.

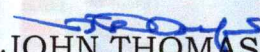
