A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO DONATE FIVE (5) UNITS OF HONDA PCX160 MOTORCYCLES TO THE QUEZON CITY FIRE DISTRICT (QCFD), AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CORRESPONDING DEED OF DONATION AND OTHER RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the General Services Department (GSD), is mandated to manage, maintain, and dispose of government properties in accordance with existing laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Fire District (QCFD) plays a vital role in ensuring public safety, emergency response, disaster preparedness, and fire protection services for the residents of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the need to strengthen and support the operational capability and mobility of the QCFD in the effective discharge of its public functions;

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WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government intends to donate five (5) units of Honda PCX160 motorcycles to the QCFD to enhance the delivery of public service and emergency response operations;

WHEREAS, the subject motorcycles are presently registered under the Quezon City Government and are more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Sangguniang Panlungsod to grant authority to the City Mayor to execute the corresponding Deed of Donation and all related documents necessary to effect the transfer of ownership of the subject motorcycles.

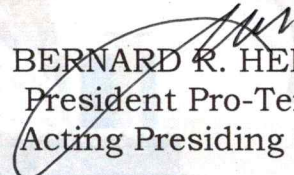
