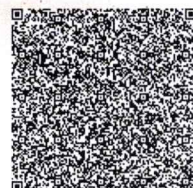

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines recognizes the rights of persons with disabilities to participate fully in society and mandates the State to promote their welfare and integration into the mainstream of society;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7277, otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Persons with Disabilities, promotes equal opportunities for employment and encourages both public and private sectors to provide gainful employment to Persons with Disabilities (PWDs);

WHEREAS, meaningful employment empowers PWDs by promoting financial independence, dignity, and active participation in economic and social life;

WHEREAS, digital technology can play a significant role in bridging employment gaps by enabling more efficient job matching, skills profiling, and employer engagement;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through initiatives of the Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO), the Public Employment Service Office (PESO), and the City's information and communications technology programs, continues to promote employment and livelihood opportunities for persons with disabilities;

WHEREAS, establishing or strengthening a digital employment platform dedicated to persons with disabilities may help connect qualified job seekers with inclusive employers and expand opportunities for remote, flexible, and accessible work.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby encourage, the development of a Quezon City digital employment and job-matching platform for Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) to connect qualified PWD job seekers with inclusive employers and expand employment opportunities in the City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Quezon City Government, through the Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO), the Public Employment Service Office (PESO), the City's information and communications technology units, and other relevant offices, is encouraged to explore the development or enhancement of digital platforms that can facilitate job matching, employment referrals, and career opportunities for persons with disabilities.

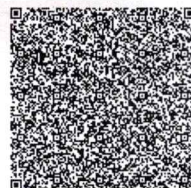
RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that barangays are encouraged to assist in identifying persons with disabilities who are seeking employment and help facilitate their registration in employment programs and digital job-matching initiatives of the City.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK), youth organizations, schools, and educational institutions are encouraged to promote digital literacy, skills development, and career readiness programs that support young persons with disabilities entering the workforce.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that non-governmental organizations, civil society groups, community organizations, and advocacy groups working with persons with disabilities are encouraged to collaborate with the Quezon City Government in providing training, mentorship, and capacity-building initiatives that will prepare PWD job seekers for employment opportunities.

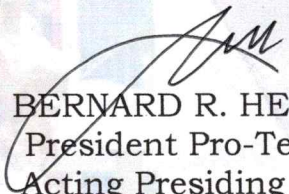
RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that private businesses, commercial establishments, and industry partners are encouraged to participate in inclusive employment initiatives by registering in such digital platforms and by providing job opportunities suitable for persons with disabilities, including remote and flexible work arrangements where feasible.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to concerned City departments, barangays, relevant agencies, and business organizations for their information and appropriate action.
