WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government remains committed to protecting the health and safety of its residents through proactive public health programs and disease prevention initiatives;

WHEREAS, dengue fever continues to be a recurring public health concern in many urban areas in the Philippines, particularly during the rainy season when mosquito breeding increases;

WHEREAS, dengue is transmitted by the Aedes mosquito and it may cause serious illness, especially among children and vulnerable individuals;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and other public health authorities emphasize that dengue prevention relies heavily on community participation in eliminating mosquito breeding sites and maintaining clean surroundings;

WHEREAS, early community awareness and preventive action before and during the rainy season can significantly reduce the risk of dengue transmission;

WHEREAS, barangays, schools, youth organizations, and community volunteers play an important role in promoting public awareness and encouraging preventive practices among residents.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby encourage, intensified community awareness and preventive measures against dengue in Quezon City.

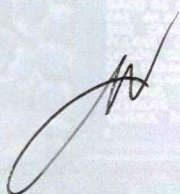
RESOLVED FURTHER, that barangays are encouraged to support regular community clean-up drives aimed at eliminating stagnant water and other potential mosquito breeding sites.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that barangays and Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Councils are encouraged to conduct information campaigns reminding residents of dengue prevention practices such as proper waste disposal, covering water containers, and maintaining clean surroundings.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that schools and youth organizations are encouraged to participate in dengue awareness initiatives and community activities that promote mosquito control and environmental cleanliness.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that residents are encouraged to remain vigilant and adopt preventive practices that reduce the risk of mosquito breeding in their homes and communities.

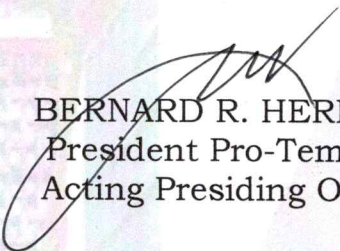

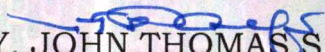
