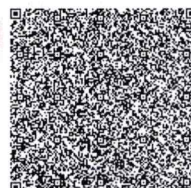
RESOLUTION NO. SP- **10552**, S-2026

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE FULL SUPPORT OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO HOUSE BILL NO. 7719, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "BARANGAY SKILLED WORKERS REGISTRY ACT," WHICH SEEKS TO ESTABLISH A VOLUNTARY REGISTRY OF SKILLED WORKERS IN EVERY BARANGAY TO IMPROVE EMPLOYMENT MATCHING, STRENGTHEN LOCAL LABOR DATA, AND EXPAND LIVELIHOOD OPPORTUNITIES AT THE COMMUNITY LEVEL

WHEREAS, the Philippine House of Representatives has approved on second reading House Bill No. 7719, otherwise known as the Barangay Skilled Workers Registry Act, principally championed by Cavite Representative Ramon Jolo Revilla III; said bill aims to establish a voluntary registry of skilled workers in every barangay nationwide;



WHEREAS, the proposed measure recognizes that many skilled workers already exist within communities but remain unseen or disconnected from potential livelihood opportunities due to the absence of a structured and accessible system that links workers with those who need their services;

WHEREAS, the bill proposes the creation of a voluntary and free registry of skilled workers at the barangay level, where individuals may list their skills, services offered, relevant training or certifications, including TESDA credentials, and other relevant information subject to written consent;

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Barangay Skilled Workers Registry will help improve employment matching, strengthen local labor data, promote inclusive economic growth, and empower workers at the grassroots level;

WHEREAS, Quezon City, as one of the largest and most populous cities in the Philippines, is home to a diverse workforce with many skilled individuals whose talents can contribute significantly to community development and local economic activity;

WHEREAS, the City also has many families with members working overseas as Overseas Filipino Workers whose skills and experience may eventually benefit the local economy upon their return.

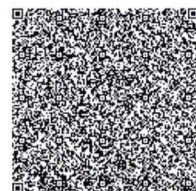
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to express, as it does hereby express, the full support of the Quezon City Government to House Bill No. 7719, otherwise known as the "Barangay Skilled Workers Registry Act," which seeks to establish a voluntary registry of skilled workers in every barangay to improve employment matching, strengthen local labor data, and expand livelihood opportunities at the community level.
