WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government continues to promote programs and policies that protect and improve the health and safety of its residents;

WHEREAS, sudden cardiac arrest is one of the leading causes of death worldwide and can occur without warning among individuals of all ages;

WHEREAS, immediate response through cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) use within the first few minutes of cardiac arrest significantly increases the chances of survival;

WHEREAS, AEDs are portable lifesaving devices designed to analyze heart rhythms and deliver electric shocks when necessary to restore a normal heartbeat;



WHEREAS, many countries and major cities around the world have implemented programs that place AEDs in public areas such as airports, malls, sports facilities, schools, and government buildings to improve emergency response;

WHEREAS, increasing public awareness and encouraging establishments to make AEDs available in accessible areas may help save lives during emergencies while waiting for professional medical assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

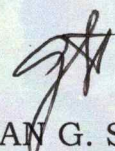
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby encourage, the installation and public accessibility of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in public places and establishments in Quezon City.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this Resolution be furnished to the Quezon City Health Department, the Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Department, the Business Permits and Licensing Department, and other concerned offices for their information and appropriate action.
