A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ORGANIZATION OF A QUEZON CITY PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PWDs) EMPLOYMENT AND LIVELIHOOD FAIR TO EXPAND JOB OPPORTUNITIES, ENTREPRENEURSHIP, AND ECONOMIC PARTICIPATION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines recognizes the right of all citizens to equal opportunities for employment and livelihood;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7277, otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Persons with Disabilities, promotes the employment of persons with disabilities and encourages the private sector to provide opportunities for inclusive employment;

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WHEREAS, employment and livelihood opportunities empower persons with disabilities to achieve greater independence, dignity, and participation in economic life;

WHEREAS, job fairs and livelihood programs serve as important platforms that connect job seekers with employers, training institutions, and support programs;

WHEREAS, organizing employment and livelihood fairs dedicated to persons with disabilities may help raise awareness among employers and promote inclusive hiring practices;

WHEREAS, Quezon City continues to support inclusive economic participation through the initiatives of various city departments including the Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO), the Public Employment Service Office (PESO), and the Small Business and Cooperatives Development and Promotions Office (SBCDPO).

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to support, as it does hereby support, the organization of a Quezon City persons with disabilities (PWDs) employment and livelihood fair to expand job opportunities, entrepreneurship, and economic participation for persons with disabilities.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Quezon City Government, through the Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO), the Public Employment Service Office (PESO), the Small Business and Cooperatives Development and Promotions Office (SBCDPO), and other relevant city departments, is encouraged to support and organize employment and livelihood fairs that provide opportunities for persons with disabilities.

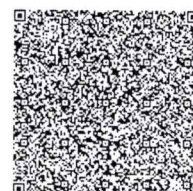
RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that barangays are encouraged to assist in identifying residents with disabilities who may benefit from employment and livelihood opportunities and help promote participation in such programs.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) and youth organizations are encouraged to assist in volunteer programs and awareness campaigns promoting inclusive employment opportunities.

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RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that non-governmental organizations, advocacy groups, livelihood organizations, and training institutions are encouraged to collaborate with the Quezon City Government in providing employment training, entrepreneurship programs, and support services for persons with disabilities.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that private sector partners, employers, business associations, and enterprises are encouraged to participate in employment fairs and promote inclusive hiring practices that provide opportunities for persons with disabilities.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to concerned city departments, barangays, business organizations, and relevant stakeholders for their information and appropriate action.
