WHEREAS, Ms. Rhebilyn Aniban, a resident of Barangay U.P. Campus, District IV, Quezon City, won a Silver Medal in the Women's 3x3 Wheelchair Basketball Event and a Bronze Medal in the Women's 5x5 Wheelchair Basketball Competition;

WHEREAS, Ms. Lorna Lilagan, a resident of Barangay San Agustin, District V, Quezon City, won a Silver Medal in the Women's 3x3 Wheelchair Basketball Event and a Bronze Medal in the Women's 5x5 Wheelchair Basketball Competition;

WHEREAS, Ms. Cathreen Gem Tanyag, a resident of Barangay Culiati, District VI, Quezon City, won a Bronze Medal in the Women's 5x5 Wheelchair Basketball Competition;

WHEREAS, through their remarkable achievements, these distinguished QCitizens have served as inspirations to fellow persons with disabilities and have brought pride, honor, and recognition not only to Quezon City but also to the entire Filipino nation.
