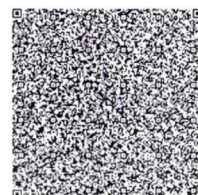

WHEREAS, the 66th Palarong Pambansa was held in Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur, bringing together the Country's finest elementary and secondary student-athletes to compete in various sporting disciplines and promote excellence, discipline, teamwork, sportsmanship, and youth development;

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WHEREAS, the National Capital Region (NCR) emerged as the Overall Champion of the 66th Palarong Pambansa, marking its nineteenth (19th) consecutive championship and reaffirming its leadership in youth sports development;

WHEREAS, thirty (30) student-athletes from various public and private educational institutions in Quezon City earned Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals in the fields of Badminton, Basketball, Baseball, Chess, Football, Futsal, Swimming, Taekwondo, Volleyball, Wrestling, Wushu, and Archery, thereby contributing to the success of the NCR delegation;

WHEREAS, the medalists represented educational institutions including Far Eastern University-Diliman, Ateneo de Manila University, University of the Philippines Integrated School, San Francisco High School, Commonwealth Elementary School, Sto. Cristo Elementary School, Fort Aguinaldo Elementary School, San Vicente Elementary School, School of Saint Anthony-Lagro, King's Montessori College, St. Pedro Poveda College, Miriam College, Justice Cecilia Muñoz Palma High School, and Jose P. Laurel Sr. High School;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City delegation produced outstanding performances in various sporting events, including championship victories in Football, Volleyball, Badminton Mixed Doubles, and Swimming Relay Events, as well as podium finishes in numerous individual and team competitions;

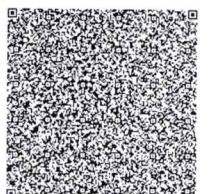
WHEREAS, five (5) Quezon City representatives likewise received Special Awards, namely: Jake Morallo of Far Eastern University-Diliman as Best Coach in Football; Jimuel Enzo Gabriel S. Panganiban of Far Eastern University-Diliman as Most Valuable Player in Football; Jimm Leowell S. Fabela of Far Eastern University-Diliman as Best Defender in Football; Jeffrey Jr. C. Fernandez of Far Eastern University-Diliman as Most Promising Player in Football; and Miguel James Padojinog of Commonwealth Elementary School as Most Valuable Player in Volleyball;

WHEREAS, the remarkable achievements of these athletes, coaches, trainers, and officials have brought honor, pride, and distinction to Quezon City and serve as an inspiration to the youth in pursuing excellence both in sports and in life.

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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, the sincerest congratulations of the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, the City Vice Mayor, Honorable Gian G. Sotto, and the Honorable Members of the 23rd Quezon City Council to the Quezon City medalists, special awardees, coaches, trainers, and officials who brought honor and distinction to the City during the 66th Palarong Pambansa held in Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur.
