A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE ORGANIZATION OF A QUEZON CITY PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PWDs) ENTREPRENEURS BAZAAR TO SUPPORT PWD-OWNED BUSINESSES, PROMOTE INCLUSIVE ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES, AND SHOWCASE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES CREATED BY PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

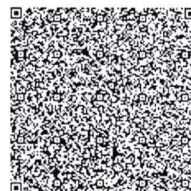
WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines recognizes the rights of persons with disabilities to participate fully in society and mandates the State to promote their welfare and integration into the mainstream of society;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7277, otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Disabled Persons, promotes the rehabilitation, self-development, and self-reliance of persons with disabilities and their integration into the mainstream of society;

WHEREAS, entrepreneurship and livelihood opportunities provide persons with disabilities with avenues for economic independence, creativity, and self-empowerment;

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WHEREAS, Quezon City continues to strengthen programs that support inclusive economic development through initiatives benefiting persons with disabilities, including programs implemented through the Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO), livelihood initiatives, and partnerships with the private sector;

WHEREAS, organizing a Quezon City PWD Entrepreneurs Bazaar can provide a platform for persons with disabilities to showcase their products and services, connect with customers, and expand their livelihood opportunities;

WHEREAS, such initiatives may also raise awareness among the public regarding the talents, creativity, and entrepreneurial potential of persons with disabilities.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby encourage, the organization of a Quezon City Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) Entrepreneurs Bazaar to support PWD-owned businesses, promote inclusive economic opportunities, and showcase products and services created by persons with disabilities.

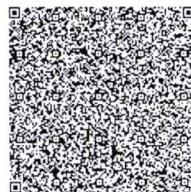
RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Quezon City Government, through relevant offices including the Persons with Disability Affairs Office (PDAO), the Small Business and Cooperatives Development and Promotions Office (SBCDPO), the Quezon City Tourism Department, and other concerned city offices, is encouraged to support and promote programs and activities that highlight entrepreneurship among persons with disabilities.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that barangays are encouraged to help identify persons with disabilities who are engaged in small businesses or livelihood activities and assist them in participating in City-supported livelihood and entrepreneurship initiatives.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK), youth organizations, schools, and community groups are encouraged to support and promote activities that highlight inclusive entrepreneurship and encourage young persons with disabilities to develop their entrepreneurial skills.

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RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that non-governmental organizations, civil society groups, and community organizations working with persons with disabilities are encouraged to collaborate with the Quezon City Government in organizing bazaars, exhibits, and livelihood programs that support PWD entrepreneurs.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that private sector partners, malls, commercial establishments, and business organizations are encouraged to provide venues, sponsorship, market opportunities, and mentorship programs that will help promote products and services developed by persons with disabilities.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to concerned city departments, barangays, relevant agencies, and business organizations for their information and appropriate action.
