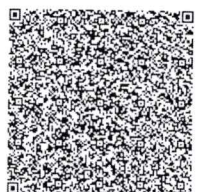

WHEREAS, Quezon City continues to promote inclusive development through various programs that support livelihood, training, and employment opportunities for different sectors of society, including persons with disabilities;

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WHEREAS, expanding access to skills development, entrepreneurship training, and livelihood initiatives for persons with disabilities can help reduce economic barriers and promote inclusive growth in the City;

WHEREAS, collaboration among the Quezon City Government, barangays, educational institutions, non-governmental organizations, and the private sector may strengthen livelihood programs that support persons with disabilities.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to support, as it does hereby support, the expansion of skills development, livelihood training, and entrepreneurship programs for persons with disabilities (PWDs) in Quezon City to support economic inclusion and sustainable livelihood opportunities.

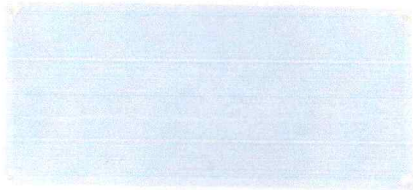

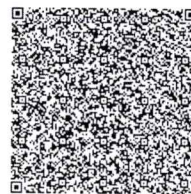
