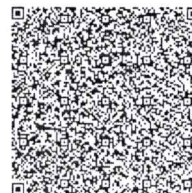

WHEREAS, President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. has appointed Dr. Jose Brittanio Sicat Pujalte, Jr., MD, MHA, CESE, FPOA, FPCS, FACS as the new Secretary of the Department of Health (DOH), succeeding Dr. Teodoro Javier "Ted" Herbosa, in recognition of his exceptional leadership, integrity, and lifelong dedication to public health and the medical profession;

WHEREAS, Dr. Pujalte is a distinguished orthopedic surgeon who graduated from the University of the Philippines College of Medicine in 1990 and completed his Orthopedic Residency Training at the Philippine Orthopedic Center in 1994, where he began a lifelong commitment to public service;



WHEREAS, Dr. Pujalte devoted decades of his professional life to the Philippine Orthopedic Center in Quezon City, culminating his appointment as Medical Center Chief II in 2014, where he strengthened hospital administration, advanced specialized orthopedic care, and served countless patients from Quezon City and the rest of the Country;

WHEREAS, by reason of his many years of dedicated service at the Philippine Orthopedic Center, Dr. Pujalte has become a true QCitizen in spirit, earning the admiration and gratitude of the people of Quezon City for his invaluable contributions to the City's healthcare system and the welfare of its residents;

WHEREAS, Dr. Pujalte has likewise made significant contributions to the advancement of orthopedic medicine, having served as President of the Philippine Orthopaedic Association and the ASEAN Orthopaedic Association, becoming one of the founding members of the Philippine Spine Society in 1995, and establishing the Philippine Shoulder Society in 1997, where he also served as its Founding President;

WHEREAS, in recognition of his outstanding leadership and excellence, Dr. Pujalte earned a Master's Degree in Hospital Administration from the Ateneo Graduate School of Business, was conferred the Career Executive Service Eligibility (CESE), and was named one of PeopleAsia's "Men Who Matter" in 2023;

WHEREAS, Dr. Pujalte's appointment as Secretary of Health is a testament to his competence, integrity, and unwavering commitment to public service, bringing pride not only to the medical profession but also to the people of Quezon City, where he dedicated much of his professional career.

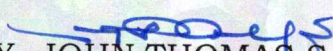
