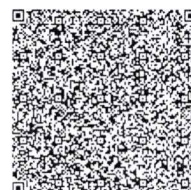

WHEREAS, his visionary, compassionate, and science-based leadership has left a lasting legacy that will continue to improve the health and well-being of present and future generations of Filipinos.

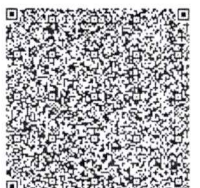
NOW, THEREFORE,

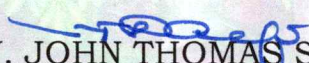
